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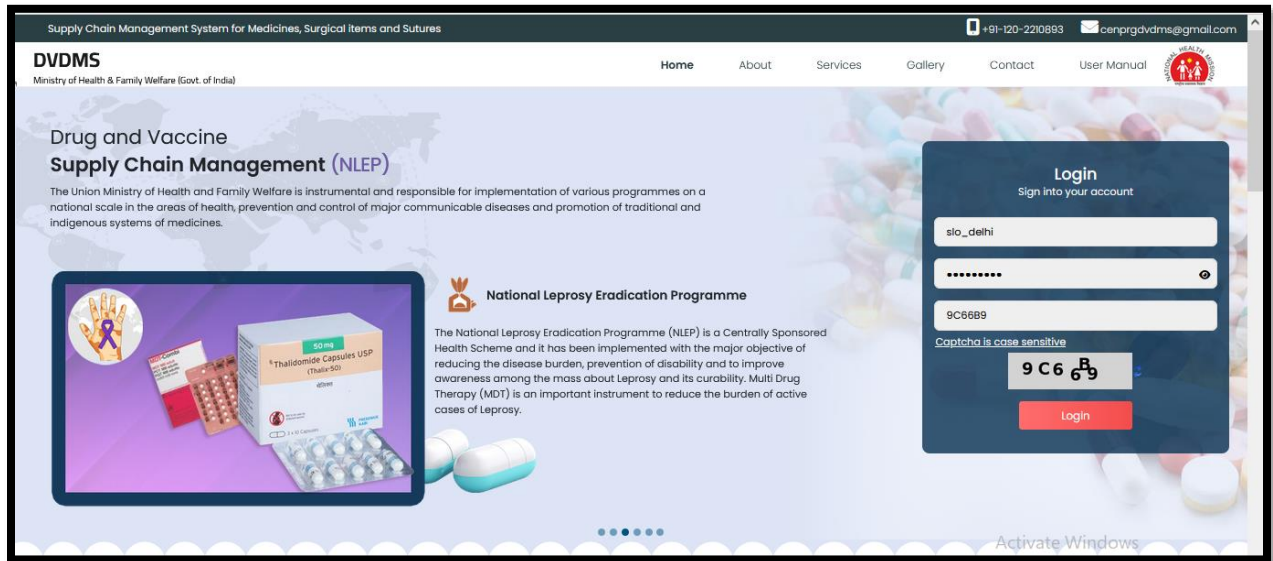

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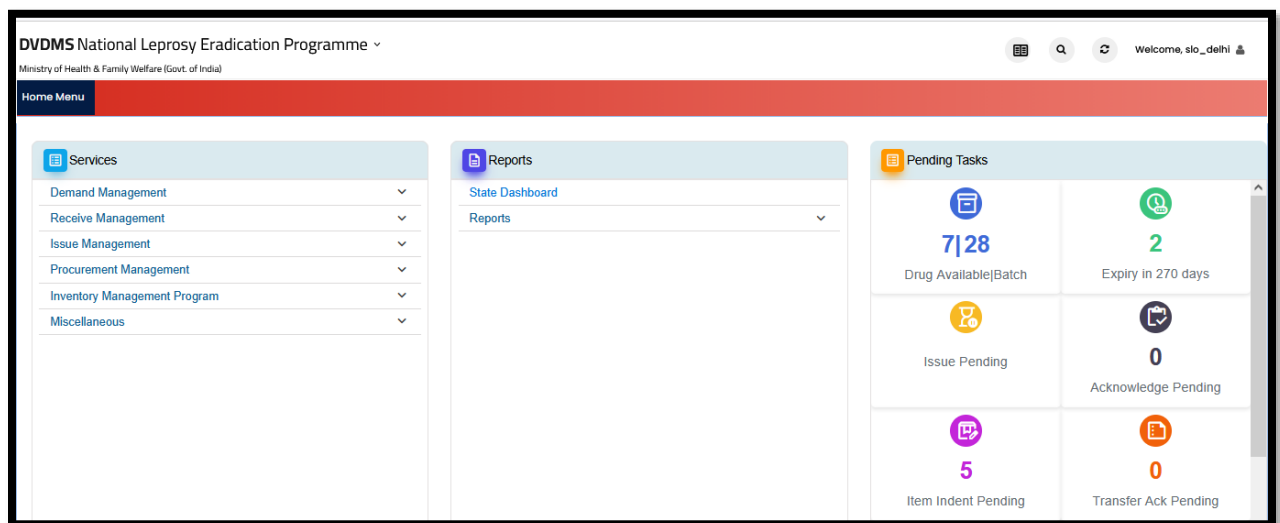

- URL: dvdmsgen.prd.dcservices.in/IMCS/login



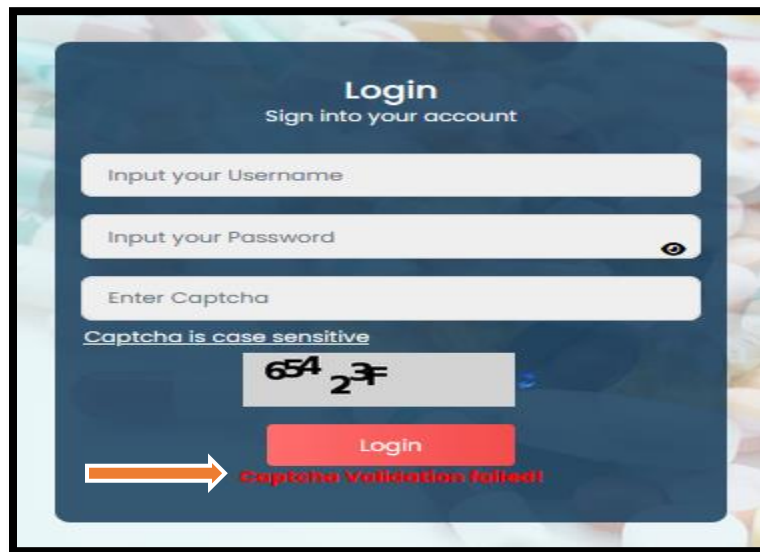

Potential errors in logging:

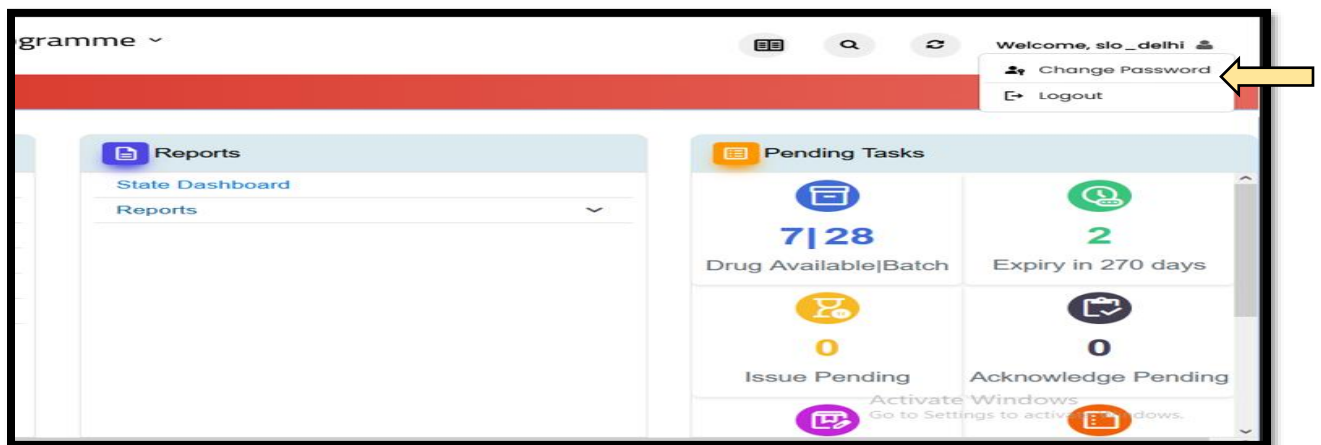
- Login may fail due to any of the following reasons:-
 - ❖ Incorrect User Name or password
 - ❖ User login expiry
 - ❖ Captcha validation failure
 - ❖ Network / Server failure.
- In all cases of login errors, the system would display relevant error message. Incorrect Login name or password. The system would display Invalid User name and Password message: As shown in img1b.

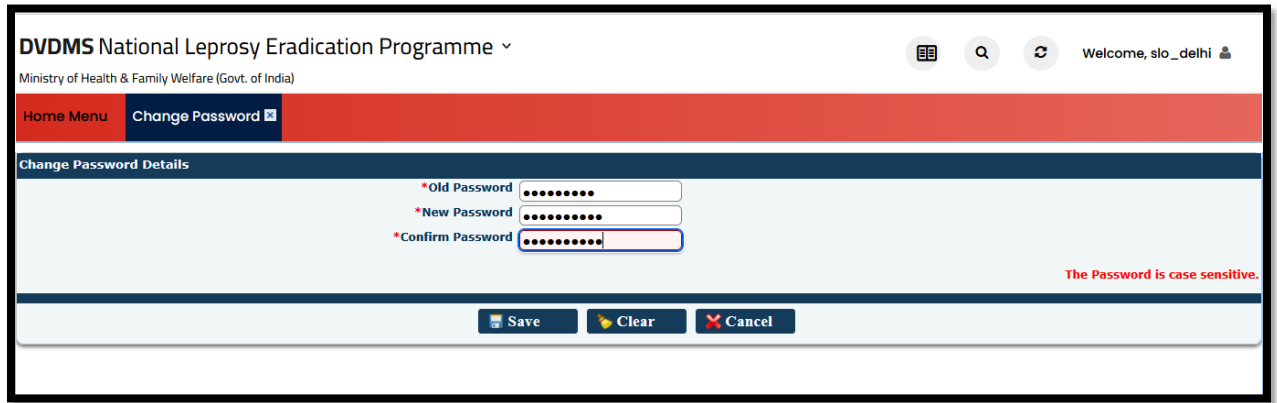
Change Password:

Step1: After your first successful login, click on the logo located at the top right corner beside your username. There, you will find the option to **Change Password**, as shown in img.1c.



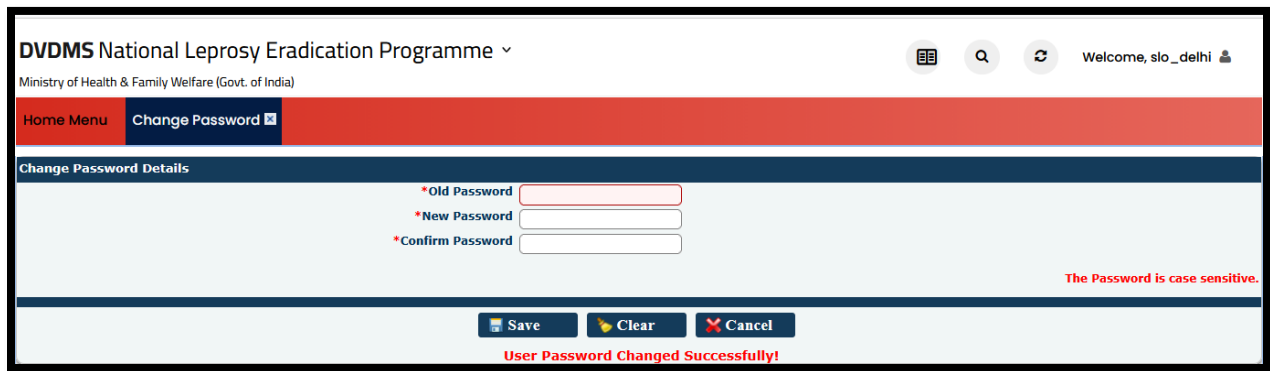

Step2: After Clicking on Change Password option a page will appear in which you need to fill Old Password, New Password and Confirm Password. The New Password and the Confirm Password field should contain the same value as shown in img.1d

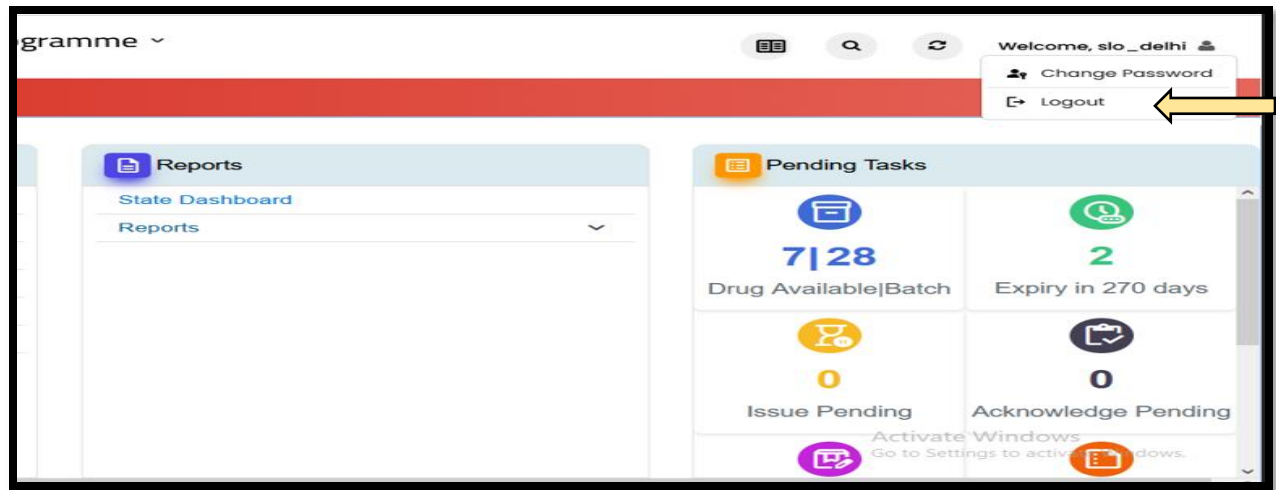
Step3: After filling the Password click on SAVE Button and your Password will be changed. An alert message will appear as *User Password Changed Successfully!*
